- **4-Day s of Training for New and Experienced Teachers as well as parents, community members and nonprofit program staff**

Comprehensive Affirmative and Negative Evidence set.
Nationally recognized faculty.
Critiqued practice debates.
Cooperative and communal atmosphere.
